With existing store locations in the malls at The Galleria, Baybrook, Memorial City, and The Woodlands, Clark is looking forward to opening the fifth store in the area. She notes, "Our plan is always to open in the premier malls across the country, and we will continue this approach as we open at First Colony. We have had many Guests who have visited our Houston area locations ask us when we will be opening in their community. Now, we will be able to reach even more of our friends and we are thrilled to be here."

Build-A-Bear Workshop continues its aggressive expansion plan nationally by opening in new markets this year, including Wichita, KS, Little Rock, AR, Des Moines, IA, Honolulu, HI, Greenville, SC, Youngstown, OH,

Springfield, MA, and Boise ID - as well as internationally. The company has been planning its global strategy for the past several years, and has opened stores in Canada, United Kingdom, Japan, Korea, and Denmark.
